08.112 - TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Councillor Booth read out a letter of resignation from Councillor Carlyle. All three Councillors being present there were no apologies.

08.113 - PLANNING APPLICATIONS -

(a) To consider the following Planning Applications

Ref: 08/02238/FUL – Permanent retention of temporary dwelling at Oakview Farm, Low Moor Lane by Mr M A Lord.	We support the application
Ref: 08/02629/FULM – Construction of 30m x 50m manege with associated fencing (resubmission) at Tancred House, Main Street by Mr Chris Digby.	 No objections but we wish to make the following points. We would prefer that the manege was built close to the eastern boundary of the property as it would reduce the wasted land on the western and northern boundaries and minimise the impact on Doon Court House and Wheatsheaf House. The initial application included lighting. We appreciate that lighting is not included in this application but we are concerned that an application for lighting may be submitted at a later date. The lighting would impact on neighbouring properties.

(b) To note Local Authority Planning Decisions

It was noted that the Local Planning Authority had approved the following application: Ref: 08/02288/CLU – Certificate of lawfulness of existing use for non-commercial keeping, riding and grazing of horses at Tancred House, Main Street by Mr Chris Digby.

08.115 – TO AGREE A PROCEDURE FOR CO-OPTING COUNCILLOR(S)

After discussion it was resolved that the Parish Council would decide the process for co-opting new Councillors after the legal process of replacing Councillor Carlyle had run its course.
